Possessive Plurals (the "Genitive Case")

English shows possession with the preposition "of" or the ending "s." Latin shows it with a "genitive" ending. For the nouns we have learned so far, the genitive plural endings are these:

us \rightarrow i \rightarrow orum (e.g. fluvii \rightarrow fluviorum of the rivers)

um \rightarrow i \rightarrow orum (e.g. oppidi \rightarrow oppidorum of the towns)

 $a \rightarrow ae \rightarrow arum$ (e.g. villae \rightarrow villarum of the houses)
